Sheffield has again been named as England's safest major city with crime and antisocial behaviour significantly reduced this last 12 months...

7% reduction in total crime,
3,015 fewer crimes making Sheffield a safe place to live, learn and work.

7% reduction in victim-based crime,
2,702 fewer victims of crime spared of the hurt and disruption caused.

22% reduction in antisocial behaviour,
10,822 fewer reports showing our commitment to improving the service we provide to victims of ASB, with specific focus to our vulnerable victims.

88% victim satisfaction rate, Sheffield provides the best quality service in the county - we will look to further improve our level of service by focusing on the needs of the victim. Working with our partners, we will focus on what matters to our communities most.

978 uninsured vehicle seizures. In order to prevent death and injury, we will continue to work with our partners to disrupt the criminal and antisocial use of our roads.
