Management TEAM PRINCIPLES

- Children are our main focus.
 The object of the exercise is to make children's lives better not our lives easier.
- Young people's futures depend on the **quality of the services** we provide for them.
- We lead by example.
- We don't have to be good mates to be team mates.
- We are all **responsible** for our actions and **accountable** for our behaviour, both individually and collectively.
- We need to respect each other, take account of each other's feelings and have regard for each other's personal dignity.
- Good outcomes follow when we collaborate, not when we compete.

- We will be helpful. When colleagues need assistance we will help them solve their problems, not add to them.
- We need to be able to give and receive feedback without falling out - anybody can talk to anybody about their performance - it is not only a top down process.
- We recognise that differences are inevitable - we deal with them directly and without hostility.
- To be effective we need clear leadership and direction
- Good communication is the key to success. We will share information freely and talk about issues constructively.

- Everybody has a contribution to make and everybody has to make a contribution. We can learn from our colleagues and from our mistakes.
- What needs to be done should be done and will be done.
 Everybody will do their fair share of work.
- Everything is negotiable (nearly) until it's negotiated, then we commit fully and collectively to the decision, no more debate!
- What we are after is positive solutions not just well defined problems.
- We are **positive and forward looking**. We recognise contributions of our colleagues and we celebrate success.
